



**Bits and Bobs Crafts Exclusive
Pattern
Pucker Up for PH
Lips Key Ring and Child's Stripy
Neck Purse**



Materials:

Size 3mm needles
Neck purse - Oddments of 3 shades of blue knitting wool (DK)
Key ring – oddments of mid blue yarn
 Blue seed beads / decorative beads
 Strong Cotton thread
 Small button
 Embroidery thread to match / contrast with button
 Key ring hoop – can buy as “D-rings” in DIY shops
 1 -2 Small pop fasteners

Abbreviations:

K – Knit; P-Purl; St - Stitch
 SS – Stocking Stitch
 Inc – Increase K2tog – K 2 together,
 K3 tog – K 3 together
 CO – cast on

Colours

A – darkest shade
 B - medium shade
 C –lightest shade

CO 1 st in A


INCREASE ROWS

Row 1 Inc twice in 1st st (3sts) in A
Row 2 **And all alternate rows see notes 1 and 2**
Row 3 Inc in 1st st p1 Inc in last st (5sts) In B
Row 5 Inc in 1st st K1 p1 K1 Inc in last st (7sts) In C
Row 7 Inc in 1st st K2 p1 K2 Inc in last st (9sts) In C
Row 9 Inc in 1st st K3, p1, k3, inc in last st (11sts) in B
Row 11 Inc in 1st st K3 Inc in next st, p1, inc in next st k3, inc in last st (15sts) in B
Row 13 Inc in 1st st K6, p1, k6, inc in last st (17sts) in B
Row 15 Inc in 1st st K6 Inc in next st, p1, inc in next st k6, inc in last st (21sts) in A
Row 17 Inc in 1st st, k9, inc in next st, p1, inc in next st, K9, inc in last st (27sts) A
Row 19 Inc in 1st st, k11, inc in next st, p1, inc in next st, K11, inc in last st (31sts) A
Row 21 Inc in 1st st, k13, inc in next st, p1, inc in next st, K13, inc in last st (35sts) A

SHAPE TOP LIPS

Row 23 Inc 1st in each of first 2 sts, K13, Inc 1 in next 2 sts, p1, Inc 1 in next 2 sts, K9, inc 1st in each of next 2 sts (43sts) in A
Row 25 K 21, Inc 1 in next st, p1, Inc 1 in next st k20 (45sts) in B
Row 27 K 2tog, K19, Inc 1 in next st, p1, Inc 1 in next st k19 K2tog (45sts) in B
Row 29 K2 tog, k19, inc 1 in next st, p1, inc 1 in next st, K19, K2tog (45sts) in B
Row 31 K22, p1, K22 in C
Row 33 Inc in 1st, K19, K2tog, p1, K2tog, K19, inc 1st in each of next 2 sts (45sts) in C
Row 35 Inc in 1st, K17, K2tog, p1, K2tog, K14, inc 1st in each of next 2 sts (41sts) in B

- 1. For Stripy Neck purse: work in Garter St (every row K) throughout**
- 2. For Key Ring Coin Purse, work in Stocking Stitch – purl all even rows**

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- Row 37** K19, K2tog, p1, K2tog, K19 in A
Row 39 K3tog, k17, p1, k17, K3tog (37 sts) in B
Row 41 K2tog, k14, k2tog, p1, K2tog, k14, k2tog (33sts) in B
DECREASE ROWS
Row 43 K2tog, k12, K2tog, p1, K2tog, K13, k2 tog (29 sts) in C
Row 45 K2tog, k10, K2tog, p1 K2tog, k12, K2tog (25sts) in C
Row 47 K2tog, k8, K2tog, p1 K2tog, k10, K2tog (21sts) in C
Row 49 K2tog, k6, K2tog, p1 K2tog, k8, K2tog (17sts) in B
Row 51 K2tog, k4, K2tog, p1 K2tog, k4, K2tog (13sts) in B
Row 53 K2tog, k2, K2tog, p1 K2tog, k2, K2tog (9sts) in B
Row 55 K2tog, k1, K2tog, p1 K2tog, K1, K2tog (7sts) in B
Row 57 K3tog, p1, K3tog in B
Row 59 K3 tog, pull yarn through loop to fasten off A

I Cord for neck purse

Using 2 dpn's cast on 4 sts, K 1 row, slide sts to other end of needle, k 1 row until cord is long enough to go round child's neck to allow purse to hang at mid chest using the following pattern sequence

Row 1 – A, Row 2 – B, Rows 3 C – carrying the yarn up the back – this should “hide itself” as the cord joins

Making Up:

1. Fold purse in half down centre line , with right sides facing (centre line is the Kst you'll see on your P rows
2. Sewing in loose ends, join both side to start of shaping for lips – this will make the gap where you can take coins in and out of your purse
3. Turn out the right way
4. Stitch a small button in the centre of the purse if you would like to
5. Take 10cm of yarn and twist to make a twisted cord, sew both ends to centre of back of purse to make a loop. Stitch a small loop close to the bottom of the large loop, by joining the 2 sides of it, to fit round the button.
6. Apply 1 -2 pop fasteners to the inside of the purse, at the lip shaping for added security

Key Ring

1. Attach the strong cotton to the key ring loop / D ring, using a hitch knot – this will give you 2 strands of cotton hanging from the loop which should be about 6cm long
2. Thread a beading needle with the hanging strands
3. Thread on up to 15 seed beads or 10 seed beads and one decorative bead of your choice as shown in the picture
4. Firmly stitch this beaded cotton onto one corner of your purse

Neck Purse

1. Once I cord is complete, join each end firmly to a corner of the purse
2. Decorate the join with a bead or button if required
